- Defending airlines in CEDR Adjudications and County Court proceedings for claims arising under Regulation 261 and the Montreal Convention;
- Attending and conducting Case and Cost Management Conferences;
- Assisting in two disclosure exercises in on-going litigation, one concerning delay in a large construction project, the other allegations of fraud, misrepresentation and breach of warranty.
